## Common Types

**SEX**

strip clubs, massage parlors, brothels, and houses in your community

domestic work, agriculture, mining, construction, and manufacturing

**LABOUR**

Traffickers commonly trick victims with false promises of:  
**EMPLOYMENT  
EDUCATION  
RELATIONSHIP**

## Human Trafficking Involves:

### ACTS

*What is done*

- Delivers
- Recruits
- Transports
- Transfers
- Harbours
- Sells/Leases
- Exchanges
- Receives

### MEANS

*How it is done*

- Threat of harm
- Use of Force/Coercion
- Fraud/Deception
- Kidnapping/Abduction
- Abuse of Power
- Direct or indirect giving or receiving of payments, rewards, or any other advantage

### PURPOSE

*Why it is done*

- For any Exploitation:
- Sex
  - Labour
  - Removal of Organs
  - Illegal Adoption
  - Forced Marriage
  - Debt Bondage
  - Drugs
  - Cyber

**Acts + Means + Purpose = Trafficking**

- For minors under 18, MEANS is not required to be Trafficking.
- Consent is immaterial if a MEANS is present.
- Victims do not have to cross borders to be Trafficked.
