It is the **EXPLOITATION** of vulnerable people.

Common Types

strip clubs, massage parlors, brothels, and houses in your community

domestic work, agriculture, mining, LABOUR construction, and manufacturing

Traffickers commonly trick victims with false promises of: **EMPLOYMENT EDUCATION RELATIONSHIP**

Prevention and Combating of Trafficking in Persons Act

Human Trafficking Involves:

ACTS

What is done

- Delivers
- Recruits
- Transports
- Transfers
- Harbours
- Sells/Leases
- Exchanges
- Receives

MEANS

How it is done

- Threat of harm
- Use of Force/Coercion
- Fraud/Deception
- Kidnapping/Abduction
- Abuse of Power
- · Direct or indirect giving or receiving of payments, rewards, or any other advantage

PURPOSE

Why it is done

For any Exploitation:

- Sex
- Labour
- Removal of Organs
- Illegal Adoption
- Forced Marriage
- Debt Bondage
- Drugs
- Cyber

Acts + Means + Purpose = Trafficking

- For minors under 18, MEANS is not required to be Trafficking.
- Consent is immaterial if a MEANS is present.
- Victims do not have to cross borders to be Trafficked.
